Mexico Mission Family Bio- The Cruz de león Moreno family will be receiving a new home made possible by our church family. Carlos and his wife are living in the 'Riconcito' community of Tijuana, Mexico. They were selected by Pastor Armando Ponce to receive their home. Carlos (59) and his wife Lilia Elizabeth (56) are in urgent need of a new home, as their current one is in very poor condition. Carlos works as a merchant to support Lilia Elizabeth and himself, earning \$40/week. The couple moved from Mexicali, Mexico to Tijuana, Mexico in 2000 for work. A new home will allow them more space for their family, security and better living conditions overall. When a new home is built, it helps the family spend their earnings elsewhere, such as on food and clothing, rather than buying new building materials for their current home.
