The Mission Committee Would like to share some of the good things that are happening with mission funds. We are supporting Mary Akiyos village in Uganda in two ways. We were able to get solar panels for the sewing center to lower costs and lengthen hours for the women who use it for income. We were also able to buy Bibles in the native language for many in the village who requested them. We also requested and received a grant to buy bunk bed frames for the school dorm for Gabriel's Helping Hands for South Sudan. A generous donor supplied the mattresses and bedding. HHSS currently supports 1500 students in 6 schools. Thank you so much for your support!
