What Would Jesus Do - As a First-Century Jewish Rabbi?

Did Jesus sleep outside? Wear a yarmulke? Depend on charity? Allow women to come close? Use the same teaching techniques as other rabbis? Sit at a table during the Last Supper?

Join us for a **light lunch**, followed by a discussion of these and other fascinating questions at a special Lenten Reflections program **following the worship service on Sunday, March 10.** Led by **Pastor Erica Rader**, we'll consider how the "real" Rabbi Jesus taught and lived, with an emphasis on the week before his death.

We'll base our discussion on the book *Sitting at the Feet of Rabbi Jesus: How the Jewishness of Jesus Can Transform Your Faith,* by Ann Spangler and Lois Tverberg.
